THREE NEW SUBURBS NAMED

AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH
OF THE
CENTENARY PROJECT
BRISBANE



This is the latest aerial photograph of the whole of the Centenary Project, showing the position of the last three residential suburbs of the Project in relation to Jindalee, Mt. Ommaney and Jamboree Heights.

The two most westerly suburbs, named Riverhills and Westlake, will be released soon, and Middle Park, the third suburb, situated west of Jamboree Heights, will be developed next year.

The development of Middle Park will complete the skeleton of the original plan for the development of 3500 acres known as the Centenary Project, by Hooker Centenary Pty. Ltd.

It is expected that full development will be completed within the next ten years, producing a total of 7800 home-sites in the six residential suburbs, with an estimated population of over 31,000.

The photograph clearly shows the private 22-acre water conservation dam which gave Westlake its name.
