SINNAMON PARK

(developed and opened May 1983 by A. V Jennings)

(Windermere Estate - established 1996)
Edenbrooke Estate (part) - established

Suburb name and boundary approved by Governor in Council as an excision from 17 Mile Rocks on 13 May 1989.

Boundaries amended by Governor in Council on 11 August 1990.

Suburb named after the family of James SINNAMON (1824-1869) and Margaret SINNAMON (nee Mathers) (1821-1904), pioneer European settlers in the area.

Oldfield Road area developed as a light industry industrial estate.
